

GOSPEL COLORS PRESENTATION - ADULT

The Yellow Color Represents HEAVEN where God lives

Heaven is God's beautiful home where there is no sadness or pain and He wants us to live there with Him one day.

The Bible gives us a glimpse of what heaven will be like in **Revelation 21:3a-4** when it says, **"God's home is now among his people! He will wipe every tear from their eyes, and there will be no more death or sorrow or crying or pain. All these things are gone forever"**

Do you know for sure if you died today that you would live with God forever?

If they say YES, then ask question #2

(If they say NO, or DON'T KNOW to the first question, proceed to I John 5:13)

If God asked you, "Why should I let you into my heaven?" How would you answer Him?"

If they say good works, share Ephesians 2:8-9 (from Black Color), but only the verse and then continue where you left off in the yellow color. This will help them know that their eternal life is only found in Jesus Christ and not on the works that we do. —>Then proceed with the rest of the yellow color and the rest of the presentation.

The Bible says we can know that we have eternal life because **I John 5:13** says, **"I have written this to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, so that you may know you have eternal life."**

...God wants us to live with Him forever in Heaven, but there is one Big problem.

The Black Color Represents our Hearts Dirty with SIN

Sin is when we disobey God.

We have ALL sinned. I've sinned and disobeyed God, have you?

The Bible says in **Isaiah 59:2** **"It's your sins that have cut you off from God."**

When we sin, all we earn is death, which means an eternity away from God in a real place called hell.

The Bible says in **Romans 6:23**, **"For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord."**

Only when we accept God's gift do we get to live forever with Him

The Bible says in **Ephesians 2:8-9**, **"God saved you by his grace when you believed. And you can't take credit for this; it is a gift from God. Salvation is not a reward for the good things we have done, so none of us can boast about it."**

Eternal life is a gift that God offers; not something we can earn or work for. You can either accept or reject it. If we reject His gift, we remain separated from Him forever.

...But God doesn't want us to be separated from Him, so He sent his Son Jesus to save us.

GOSPEL COLORS PRESENTATION - ADULT

The Red Color Represents the BLOOD OF JESUS

Jesus died and shed his blood as payment for our sin.

The Bible says in **Romans 3:25**, **“God presented Jesus as the sacrifice for sin. People are made right with God when they believe that Jesus sacrificed his life, shedding his blood.”**

God loves you so much He was willing to give His Son for you so that you can live with Him in heaven.

Here are a few important facts about Jesus:

- Jesus Christ did what we couldn't do and lived a perfect sinless life.
- Jesus paid the price for our sins by taking our place on the cross.
- Jesus Christ came back from the dead and is in Heaven preparing a place for those who believe in Him.

Would you like to be sure Jesus is preparing a place for YOU in heaven?

In **John 14:6** Jesus said, **“I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one can come to the Father except through me.”**

...Sin makes our hearts dirty and only Jesus can make them clean again.

The White Color Represents a Clean Heart

A Clean Heart means a heart healed from sin. Jesus' death and resurrection makes a way for us to have a healed heart and a relationship with God.

The Bible says in **1 John 1:9**, **“If we confess our sins to [God], he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all wickedness.”**

When a person is forgiven of their sins they no longer have to fear death or hell.

God is ready to forgive you and welcome you into His family.

Can I ask you some questions?

1. Do you want to live with God forever in heaven one day?
2. Do you admit that you have sinned?
3. Do you believe Jesus died so you could be forgiven?
4. Do you want to put your trust in Jesus and follow him forever?

Before we put our trust in Jesus Christ, the Bible says we must repent of our sins. To repent means to turn from our way of living and start living for God.

Would you like to repent of your sin and pray with me to surrender your life to Jesus Christ?

The way you can repent and ask God to forgive your sins is by asking Him in a prayer.

If you are ready I will say a prayer, please repeat after me if you agree with the words I say.

Remember, when we pray to God, He hears us and knows when we speak from our hearts.

“Dear God, I want to live with you in heaven one day. I admit that I have sinned. I believe Jesus died so I can be forgiven. I choose to put my trust in you and to follow you forever. Amen.”

The Green Color Represents NEW LIFE

New Life is what we are given when all our sins are forgiven and we are accepted into God's family.

The bible says in **2 Corinthians 5:17** that, ***“Anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun!”***

God loves you and He has a purpose for your life. It is important for us to grow closer to God so that we can understand that purpose and begin to experience a deeper relationship with Him.

The Bible says in **Colossians 2:6-7**, ***“Just as you accepted Christ Jesus as your Lord, you must continue to follow him. Let your roots grow down into him, and let your lives be built on him.”***

Here are four things to do that are very important in growing closer to God:

1. **Prayer.** Praying is the way we talk to God. God loves you and wants to hear from you.
2. **Reading the Bible.** The Bible is a way that God talks to us. When we read it, He can reveal things we need to change or things we should do that pleases him.
3. **Going to Church.** Hanging out with people that believe what you do. When we hang out with others who believe in Jesus they can help us grow a strong faith. You should come check out church with me sometime soon!
4. **Tell others about Jesus.** Telling others about Jesus not only fulfills our calling to share our faith, but it helps those around us to be sure of their eternity too.
